Northport Village Corporation Infrastructure Tour:

Wharf: Village Agent Bill Paige explained what repairs had been done to the wharf recently, and what repairs may be needed next year. A marine engineer will examine the structure and supports in the early spring and provide an estimated cost of ongoing maintenance and upkeep. Tucker explained that if the Town had an estimate of the expected costs by February 2023, it would help the Town and Village budget for any repairs.

Catch Basins: Paige provided a list and count of catch basins in the Village and showed where most of the catch basins are. He explained some of the rainwater drainage issues that the Village has, and explained that some catch basins may need to be repaired, and some more catch basins may need to be added in trouble spots.

Pleasant Street: Novotny and Paige explained some of the rainwater drainage issues with Pleasant Street, and that it may need to be paved in order to address those issues.

General Road Maintenance: Paige explained that some of the aprons between the paved and unpaved roads will also need to be done whenever the paved roads are repaved. Paige explained some of the problems with the culverts on Shore Road and George Street near the Village Office. He felt that those culverts may need to be upsized to handle heavy rains. He also thought that catch basins could be added at Oak and George Streets, and that ditching and a culvert at Maple Street could help direct water flow.

Adjourn: *Pinkham Bebb motioned to adjourn the meeting at 4:56 pm, seconded by Tucker. Board voted 3-0, motion passed.*
