 - a. Cost of recycling
 - b. Ease of recycling
 - c. Effectiveness of recycling
- 3. Discuss: Northports current problems that could/should be addressed by this law?
 - a. Specific materials (eg glass)
 - b. Collection infrastructure
 - c. Transportation
- 4. Brainstorm a statement: Issues the rules should address that would benefit Northport and others.
- 5. Outline a statement to submit to DEP:
 - a. Topics to include
 - b. Order of importance
 - c. Who should this be addressed to and who should receive this?
 - d. When does it need to be submitted?
- 6. Final assignment
 - a. Will we draft a statement?
 - b. Who will submit it? Recycling Committee? Select board?
 - c. Who will write it?
 - d. How to review and approve?
 - e. Deadlines? (Public comment period ends Monday, March 18)
