

**OFFICIAL WARRANT FOR THE TOWN OF NORHTPORT  
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
To be held on January 21, 2026**

To: Amy Eldridge, Town Clerk of the Town of Northport in the County of Waldo State of Maine.

**GREETINGS:**

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Northport in said County and State, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to appear at the Edna Drinkwater School, 56 Bayside Road, in the Town of Northport, on Wednesday, January 21, 2026, at 6:00 p.m., there and then to act upon Articles 1 and 2.

**Article No. 1:** To Choose a Moderator to preside at said Town Meeting.

***On Wednesday, January 21, 2026, Town Clerk Amy Eldridge opened the meeting at 6:07pm by greeting those present at the Edna Drinkwater School for the purpose of action on Articles 1 and 2. Motion was made by Robin Coombs and seconded by Paul Sheridan, to have Lee Woodward, Jr., serve as Moderator over the Special Town Meeting. Three ballots were cast in favor of Woodward. Eldridge recited the oath to Woodward, swearing him in as Moderator over Town Meeting.***

**Article No. 2:** Shall the Town vote to authorize the Select Board to enter into a contract with Sundog Solar to purchase and install a solar array on Town-owned property at 216 Beech Hill Road (Tax Map R07-022)?

*Note: A copy of the proposed contract is available for inspection at the Town Office and on the Town's website at northportmaine.org. The contract price for the 42-kilowatt array is \$117,500. The Select Board expects to pay for the entire project only through grants and donations. This article des not authorize the spending of any monies other than those already appropriated or those raised through grants and donations.*

***Motion was made and seconded to approved the article as written. Woodward called for questions & comments. Many questions were asked and answered about the design, maintenance, recycling, and projected cost savings from the solar array. Danny Piper, Sundog Solar, answered some questions. Woodward called for any further questions & comments. Hearing none, all votes in favor, none opposed. Article approved.***

***With no other articles, a Motion was made, and seconded, to adjourn at 6:47 pm. All in favor, none opposed. Meeting adjourned.***
