Northport is conducting a capital campaign to build a new community center and town office. This facility will provide excellent and accessible service to all residents, create a space to gather, and strengthen community ties for generations to come.

Whether your family has been here since 1796 or you have just found your way to Northport, you can help!

Building a Stronger Northport

The new community center and town office will:

- Serve as an event center, available for everyone, whether it's a farmer's market, family reunion, Saturday night dance, concert, movie, community supper, Senior College class, or support group meeting. The revenue generated from renting the space to outside groups will help cover the operating costs.
- Provide a public reading room with high-speed internet for residents who lack it at home. This space will also host children's story hours or book clubs.
- Function as an emergency shelter during extreme weather events.
- Reduce the town's carbon footprint and operational costs with energy-efficient heat pumps, state-of-the-art insulation, and the potential for a solar array.
- Be fully accessible to every taxpayer and user.

A Gift to the Future

A new building is a challenging project for a small town, especially one that works hard to keep taxes as low as possible. But the new Community Center is an investment that will help us rekindle our sense of connection to one another.

Northport has always been a place where neighbors come together to help each other, and this new center will be a physical reminder that these ties are what matter most.

A Note on Our Journey

The Vision: The dream for a new community center began in 2017, but was delayed by unforeseen global challenges.

The Commitment: Despite setbacks, the project has gained momentum, with voters approving a bond in June 2025 to get us to this stage.

The Challenge: Private donations are critical to the success of a capital campaign that will directly reduce the amount the town must finance, lessening the impact on all taxpayers.

The Opportunity: With \$2.325M in federal funding and generous donations and pledges so far, we are well on a path to meeting our fundraising goals.
