Building Opportunities for Northport

Northport needs a new town office, and **we need your help.**

Building a new Town Office & Community Center will help strengthen our community!

Current Building

- Structurally unsound
- Limited insurance
- Insufficient storage space for vital town records
- No potable water
- Inadequate space for elections and public meetings
- Not accessible/ADA compliant
- Not a viable public emergency shelter
- Inefficient and expensive to heat and cool

New Building

- Meet current building & fire safety codes
- Provide secure, fire-proof storage for town records & maps
- Safe & energy-efficient offices
- House an 88-seat meeting room with a serving kitchen
- New showers, an office, and storage for volunteer firefighters
- Public space with access to WiFi and town records
- Adequate shelter for weather emergencies

Why Now?

The answer is simple: our existing building is **unsafe** and poses a financial risk. Building costs will never decrease. Northport has outgrown the space. The new building will give the people of Northport not only a modern, open, welcoming space but also a centralized meeting location, a beacon in our community!

How Much?

The estimated cost for this project is \$5.2M (Jan., 2025). Town officials are working hard to find funding to minimize the burden to taxpayers. These efforts include applying for grants, launching a Capital Campaign, and reapplying for 2026 congressional funding. A municipal bond will cover any remaining expenses.
